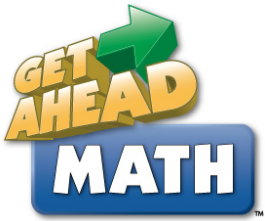


Student Scores Improve with *Get Ahead Math*™

Goals/Objectives

Utilize *Get Ahead Math* to provide individualized instruction, practice, and assessment to classes of students that represent different grade levels and different math ability levels.

Overview

Pasadena Educational Foundation, a nonprofit organization founded in 1971, provides students within Pasadena Unified School District additional opportunities for learning. Each year, the Pasadena Educational Foundation offers PUSD students the opportunity to enroll in courses offered through their Summer Enrichment Program. The program includes a full array of offerings that include: math courses, reading courses, and enrichment courses.

During the summer of 2005, the Pasadena Educational Foundation’s Summer Enrichment Program offered three separate courses of *Get Ahead Math*. A total of fifty 3rd through 6th grade students worked on the *Get Ahead Math* program for 1 hour and 15 minutes each day, four days each week, for five weeks. Utilizing the *Get Ahead Math* Pre-Test found at each level, students’ skills were assessed and they were placed at the appropriate level within the program. Students then followed the *Get Ahead* 4-Step Learning Method™ to master each level’s key objectives. When students completed a level within *Get Ahead Math*, they then took the program’s built-in Post-Test to measure academic growth. While *Get Ahead Math* was the main source of direct instruction, practice, and assessment for all students, a teacher was present to manage and implement the use of the program.

Results

After five weeks of using *Get Ahead Math*, students’ test scores showed significant improvement.

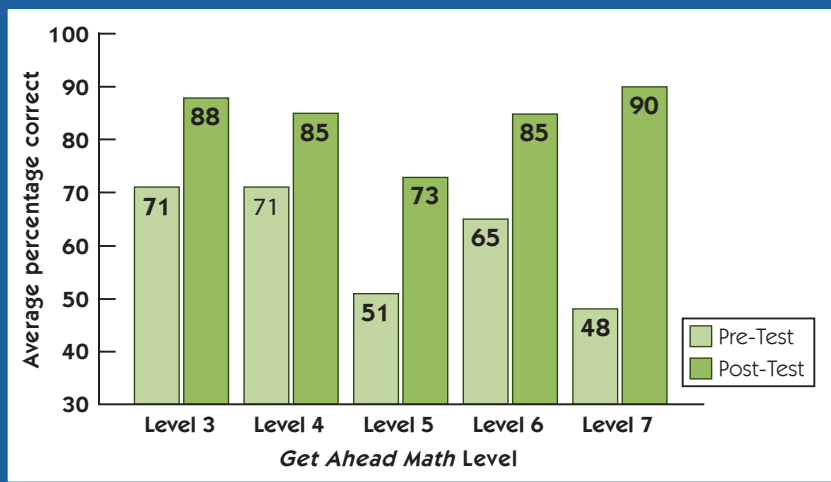
